VISITOR PARKING LOT AT SUMMIT PLACE

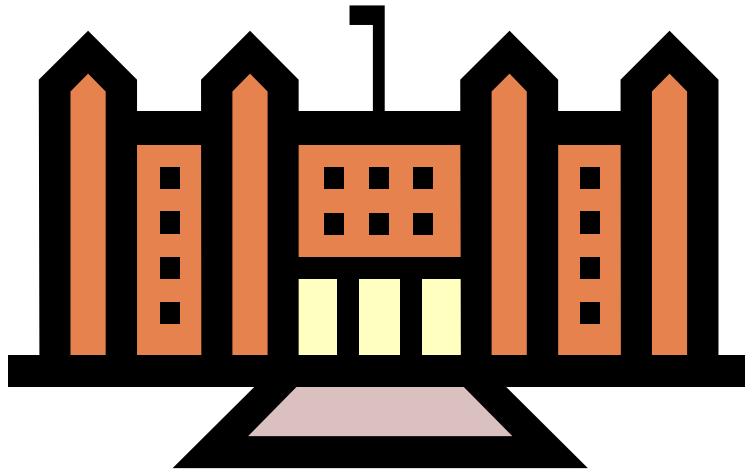
There is a Visitor Parking Lot in front of Summit Place, to the East of the front door of the building. All visitors to the Service Center, including Service Board members, ISRs, and Service Center volunteers may park in that lot. If you are leaving before 6pm on a week day you will need to get a "voucher" from the Service Center, which you will exchange at the guard's desk for a token that you will use at the lift gate to exit the parking lot. There is no token needed on weekends.

The front door of the building is handicap accessible. Handicap parking is designated in the lot to the West of the front door of Summit Place. No token is required to exit the West lot. Handicapped visitors may also use the Visitor Parking Lot if they wish.

Parking is also available in the parking structure, and the city lot at the East end of Washington Street.

The Al-Anon International Convention has already passed. It was a great time. If you've never been to an International please consider going to the one in British Columbia in 2013 or the AA International with Al-Anon participation in San Antonio in 2010. Try to get members together to share rooms. Being with recovering people in this setting is inspiring. It has "ratcheted up" my recovery.
